

One Pager Directions and Rubric (7th Grade)

After reading your assigned novel, using the information below, create a One Pager to represent the novel. Complete the One Pager on a sheet of white cardstock. Your name should be on the back.

\_\_\_\_\_ Include the book title and author's name. (5 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Include two significant character quotes. Include the page number of the quotes and explain why each is significant. (10 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Include three images to symbolize characters or events in the novel and a statement explaining each. (12 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Create a border using the theme of the novel. (10 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Create word clusters describing each of three characters. Include the character's name as well as traits. (12 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Describe or illustrate the main conflict within the novel. (10 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Include an overall representation of the setting of the novel. (10 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Make one text to world and one text to self connection. (6 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Use an attractive color scheme with virtually no empty space. (5 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ All text is legible, dark, and attractive. Final text is not written in pencil. (5 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Error free in grammar, mechanics, and spelling. (5 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Attention to detail, high quality of work, unfolded without creases and crumples. (5 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ Quality of work reflects knowledge and understanding of the novel. (5 points)
